


#### SPDX 2013 Roadmap



#### **Content Descriptions**

- Spdx.org
  - This is a re-vamp of the web site look and feel to be more like other LF working group websites; It will also include a real media wiki along with other general improvements.



### **Specification Releases**

- SPDX Specification 1.2
  - This is a place holder for any minor adjustments to the 1.1 Specification. This release may not occur if there are not substantial issues found in 1.1.
- SPDX Specification 2.0
  - This is the next major release of the specification. SPDX 2.0 will extend the specification beyond the package level scope and enhance it to address the needs of corporate supply chains and other key identified use cases.

Release of a specification will also have a corresponding release of the tools at the same level. For example the 1.1 specification had the 1.1 release of tools. If a 1.2 specification is done then there will be a 1.2 tools. For 2.0 there will be a 2.0 Tools release.

Note: It is historical that we usually release versions of the specification at the time of the LF Collab Summit or at LinuxCon NA.



- SPDX License list updates will be done on a roughly quarterly basis if there are new licenses to be added.
- If a release of the License List is done, then the roadmap will be updated to change the Place Holder to the actual license list version done.
